It all began over a thousand years ago in the Vallagarina valley in the southern part of Trentino- Alto Adige when San Leonardo was founded as a monastery in 900 A.D. It was later acquired by the Marquises Guerrieri Gonzaga, who have been the passionate custodians for the last 300 hundred years; in fact, Marchese Carlo and his son Anselmo are still managing the estate nowadays.

The estate first gained notoriety with the 1982 harvest when Marchese Carlo created the wine “San Leonardo”, a wine produced from international varieties that quickly became famous for its elegance. The family’s first real winemaker, however, was Carlo Guerrieri Gonzaga, his training directed not only by what was required to personally manage the family agricultural concern, but above all by a lively curiosity for the world’s great wines, most importantly, with the products of Bordeaux.

This interest led to his decision to study oenology in Lausanne, France and to deepen his knowledge with research trips to France and Tuscany. It was on the San Guido property, that he began the long, profitable partnership with Mario Incisa della Rocchetta, owner of the famed estate, who revealed all the secrets of the Bordeaux blend to Carlo and became his “oenological godfather” to all intents and purposes.

The Monti Lessini are the mountains that protect the San Leonardo estate from the cold north winds, 300 hectares that every day enjoy the beneficial effects of breezes blowing up from Lake Garda and bringing with them tempering influences. San Leonardo is in the middle of the mountains, in a sort of canyon that has four hours of sunshine less than Valpolicella, allowing San Leonardo to produce wines with slightly lower alcohol.

Carménère

is the signature of San Leonardo since it is present in each wine in a small amount. Anselmo, Carlo’s son liked the Carménère very much that in 2005 decided against his father’s will and purchased few magnums to bottle this wine.

The results surprised both of them, and since 2010, a 100% Carménère has been produced at the winery.





At San Leonardo, which has been fully organic since 2015 and today employs several biodynamic practices, there are 25 hectares of vineyards that are situated at a relatively low elevation of 150 metres. Merlot is planted in gravel-rich soils that were once the bed of a branch of the Adige. Sandier, pH-neutral soils, at elevations of 150-200 metres, are planted to Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, and Carménère. All the vineyards are in well-drained, nutrient-poor soils that yield grapes whose wines boast levels of anthocyanins that are unusually high, and not just for Trentino. Only red-wine grapes are cultivated in the vineyards behind Tenuta San Leonardo's ancient stone walls: they produce four wines, San Leonardo, Villa Gresti, Terre di San Leonardo, and Carménère.

Ten hectares are dedicated to growing white-wine grapes, planted in the Val Cembra, with soils and climate that ensure grapes with distinctive crispness and minerality and wines of great identity and elegance. Vinified exclusively in cement vats with spontaneous fermentation, without the use of selected yeasts, the wines are not filtered and have an extremely low sulphite content with balanced alcohol that is never above 13%; potential for extremely long ageing and evolution is excellent.

Carménère, the variety that gives San Leonardo's wines their uniqueness and great character and has been present in the Estate since 1850, was brought in the property from the beginning; interestingly, at first this varietal was mistaken as Cabernet Franc.

VETTE DI SAN LEONARDO

Blend: **100% Sauvignon Blanc**

Vette (in Italian "peaks of the mountains") is named for the imposing peaks that rise above this Sauvignon Blanc vineyard. It is the true height of refreshing crispness and earthy minerality.

The vines are grown exclusively on the pergola from plantings ranging from 5 to 15 years old. Crisp sauvignon blanc from vineyards at 300 - 400 meters altitude in the Dolomites. Elegant, fruity, floral, mineral notes with classic well-balanced acidity of San Leonardo wines.





SAN LEONARDO

Blend: **60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Carménère, 10% Merlot**

Coming from the **oldest vineyards of Carménère**, this wine is the very quintessence of our growing area, thanks to its innate ability to evolve over the years.

This wine is created only using the Carménère from the older vines of the estate. Very spicy and elegant with excellent aging potential. Limited edition only produced in the best vintages. All bottles are numbered.



VILLA GRESTI

Blend: **90% Merlot, 10% Carménère and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon.**

A refined union of Merlot and Carménère, Villa Gresti exhibits sublime texture and silky-smooth tannins. Villa Gresti takes its name from the family house in the estate. Inside the villa was signed the preliminary armistice between Italia and Austrian army.

Marchese Carlo dedicated this wine to his grandmother inspired by her courage as she saved 12.000 prisoners from concentration camps in Russia. A unique cru grown on a single hill at the estate.



TERRE DI SAN LEONARDO

Blend: **50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Merlot, 10%**

Carménère is the second wine of San Leonardo. From the same terroir, it follows in the footsteps of its "elder brother," with remarkable crispness and enviable balance.

Fruity and fresh, it is a more approachable wine upon release

CARMENÈRE

Blend: **100% Carmenère**

Coming from the oldest vineyards of Carménère, this wine is the very quintessence of our growing area, thanks to its innate ability to evolve over the years.

Spontaneous 15/18-day fermentation in small concrete vats with periodic pumpovers and délestage. The wine is matured for 24 months in new, once-, and -twice used French oak barrels.

GIOVANNI ROSSO

One of eleven communes where Barolo can be produced, Serralunga d'Alba is home to some of the most classically styled examples of this wine.

The typical Barolo from Serralunga d'Alba has robust tannins that enable the wines to age for many years, as much as three to four decades in the finest vintages. It is here that Davide Rosso sources his fruit and crafts some of the most elegant of all Serralunga Barolos.

For over a century now the Rosso family has been working its own vineyards in Serralunga d'Alba. A story of love, knowledge and great care, linked to important plots located in the cru Vigna Rionda, Serra, Broglio, Lirano and Damiano located in the southern area of the village, and Cerretta, Meriame, Sorano and Costabella located in the northern part. At the beginning of the 1980s, Giovanni Rosso along with his wife Ester Canale restructured most of the vineyards with an implant designed to produce only high-quality grapes.

In 2001, at the age of twenty-seven, their son Davide, a winemaker with important local and international experience, decided to personally take care of the wine making and *élevage* with the belief that: **"the wine must be the perfect copy of its terroir."** That terroir is the magic land of Serralunga d'Alba, one of the best in the world and in the Barolo area.



VIGNA RIONDA

The story of a prestigious plot



A story that began a century ago. Tommaso Canale shared his passion for wine with his wife Esterina and in the early 1930, with a pioneering attitude and enormous economic sacrifices, began to acquire some of the most beautiful vineyards in Serralunga d'Alba, the best in Langhe area for viticulture. Along with these plots, in 1934, arrived the purchase of the crown jewel: Vigna Rionda. They worked hard, with courage, strength of spirit and determination, even when atmospheric phenomena threatened the harvest. Every member of the family was ready to roll up the sleeves. Their sons Aldo and Amelio gave a great contribution working in the farmland.

The war came and with it, chaos and suffering. Tommaso died in 1945. Despite the pain, Aldo and Amelio were ready to face a new challenge together. The two brothers inherited about two hectares of Vigna Rionda carrying on what their father started. They both realized that their heritage was not only a piece of land, but the enthusiasm and love their father had for the wine. Serralunga d'Alba in the blood, Vigna Rionda in the heart. The vines were replanted in 1946, the same vines that today bear magnificent fruit.

Amelio passed away in 1963. His wife Cristina Canale and her daughter Ester tried to take care of the vineyard but met great difficulties. In the 60's the workforce moved to urban factories, so the countryside depopulated slowly. Mother and daughter were forced to make a bitter choice: give up to their beloved plot. This strip of land was linked to generations of winemakers, united by a spirit of fraternity. Due to the intervention of grandmother Esterina, the vineyards were sold to Aldo, who continued to produce wine from this outstanding plot, still within the family. In 1998 he was succeeded by his son Tommaso, who bore not only his grandfather's name, but also his passion. The strong bond existing between Aldo and Amelio recurred also between their sons, Tommaso and Ester, who supported each other. Tommaso shared his great passion with his nephew Davide Rosso. In December 2010, Tommaso died, leaving an unbridgeable gap in the family. This last setback brought a sense of new cycle, repeating the story, just as a vine comes back to life when spring takes the place of winter.

Forty years after being forced to sell Vigna Rionda, Ester Canale has turned to harvest the grapes from the rows of her childhood vineyard: the rows of the legendary parcel No. 251 of Sheet No. 8 in the municipality of Serralunga d'Alba. Vigna Rionda, described by many journalists as the "Romanée-Conti of Barolo", is back home again.

VIGNA RIONDA

The story of a prestigious plot

Following the death of Tommasino Canale, Davide Rosso decided to replant part of the vineyard with clones from the original 1946 vines (about 0,80 hectares) and to conserve only few of the original rows (about 0,40 hectares). From this little portion of vineyard, seventy years old now, very low yields give life to our Barolo Ester Canale Rosso. He believed that only these particularly deep roots can authentically tell the “layered” history of the cru. It is a rigorous choice that talks about the seriousness and the research of excellence of this winery.

The replanting dates to 2011. Despite their young age, the grapes immediately expressed an incredible potential, fruit of unique characteristics of this vineyard. Therefore, the desire to produce a great Langhe Nebbiolo, able to represent, along with the celebrated Barolo Vigna Rionda, the heritage and terroir of this vineyard. Only a very limited quantity of bottles will be produced for few vintages only, at least until the young vines will accumulate enough maturity to promote Barolo. For this reason, besides being an excellent quality wine, Langhe DOC Nebbiolo Ester Canale Rosso will become a bottle of rare prestige.
