Like its Gaisberg counterpart, this displays on both the nose and palate prominent mineral characteristics, here above all crushed stone, along with prickly impressions of citrus zests, here lemon and tangerine. Apple skin and peach fuzz add to an overall sense of invigoration, but while penetratingly persistent and imposingly concentrated, this lacks, at least for now, the savor, clarity and interactive complexity of that Gaisberg, and expresses its acidity more as tartness than refreshment. I'd give it some time. (A 2007 tasted alongside it, though, was disappointingly and perplexingly diffuse and developed.)
