“Blauburgunder is Pinot Nero in Italian and Pinot Noir in French. Gottardi chooses to label its 2013 Alto Adige Blauburgunder in German. Fruit is from the celebrated Mazzon subzone that is mostly characterized by well-draining limestone soils. This is a very feminine and elegant expression with delicate tones of wild berry that are backed by menthol aromas and light shadings of black licorice. In the mouth, the wine offers a silky and very smooth performance. Balanced acidity gives the wine a lively approach and bodes well for its future evolution. The wine is aged in oak (of various sizes) for 18 months. Drink 2016-2025.”
