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"This wine seems subdued at first, with a meaty density and powerful, unyielding tannins. After a few hours in the glass, flavors of dark plum and black cherry emerge, gaining momentum as the wine picks up notes of thyme, fennel, and black spice. The Montestefano cru's south-facing slope and the high concentration of calcium in its soils contribute to the wine's firm concentration, making it a Barbaresco to hide away for a few years while the tannins soften and the complex herbal and spice flavors come out to the fore."
